Corpus Christi 11th June 2023

I am just back from a week of retreat with the Poor Clares in Arundel. It is so good to have had a time of quiet with prayer and opportunities for reflection. What I hadn't remembered was that at Arundel Cathedral they mark the Solemnity of Corpus Christi on the Thursday! For the rest of England and Wales it is today! Every year a carpet of flowers is created in the main aisle of that Cathedral and at the end of the Mass there is a Blessed Sacrament Procession into the grounds of the Castle with Benediction; then a return to the Cathedral with the Bishop carrying the Monstrance with the Blessed Sacrament over the carpet of flowers. 2023 is the 150th year since the Cathedral was built.

What an experience I had! There were hundreds and hundreds of people of all ages, some locals, others visiting from other parts. The First Holy Communion children carried baskets of petals and strewed these in front of the Blessed Sacrament. The BBC was filming in readiness for a future Songs of Praise with a drone overhead. The Procession lasted for an hour and a half. The sun shone and there was a powerful expression of faith as people knelt to receive the Benediction. Finally, I was invited to have dinner in the Castle as one of a group of around 100 guests. Corpus Christi 2023 will stay firmly in my memory.

There were so many external signs last Thursday to highlight our Catholic Faith in the Lord's Real Presence in the Eucharist. Bread and Wine truly become Jesus Christ - Body, Blood Soul and Divinity. We believe that the Lord's intention at the Last Supper was to leave us this great Gift which puts us in touch with the love which unfolded in his Life, Death and Resurrection. And because it is really the Lord, he guarantees that our worship is Divine, rooted in the intimate love of Father and Son in the power of the Holy Spirit. The Eucharist is Food for the Journey through life just as the manna sustained the people of Israel on their pathway through the desert. This Bread of Angels also opens our eyes to the needs of others, especially the suffering and so it commissions us to work for the Kingdom which Jesus inaugurated.

May our love and understanding of the Eucharist be strengthened today. Please pray for me on my 35th Anniversary of Priesthood.

There was a period with no resident Parish Priest of St. Bonaventure and Kathryn worked tirelessly to keep things going. She also kept a watchful eye on Fr. Joe Boward who lived in the Presbytery. I would ask others please to consider setting up a standing order to make your regular gift to the church. Sometimes (or often) the machines at the back of the churches play up! Standing orders should be more straightforward and give us a steady income.

We also ask those of you who are tax-payers to allow the parish to claim back the tax you have paid - GiftAid. This results in an extra source of income which doesn't cost you anything as long as you are a tax-payer. The donation must come from a bank account in the name of the taxpayer who is claiming Gift Aid which can be a joint account.
