

FR. JULIO BARCUDI GODOY writes: Dear Welwyn Garden City Parish, It is with great joy that I write this letter because on Saturday 19th August, God willing, I will be with you. Father Norbert has told me a lot about you and I am looking forward to meeting you. I introduce myself: I am 36 years old and a diocesan priest of Mallorca, Spain. I was born in Argentina but when I was 15 years old, with my family we went to live in Spain. There, a priest invited me to a summer camp and when I saw the joy of the young Christians I wanted to know more about God and the church, I started going to mass and after thinking about it a lot I entered the seminary. In 2012 I was ordained a priest (almost 11 years ago) and I have been a religion teacher for all this time and I have been a parish priest for 6 years. Now my bishop has sent me to Rome and I am studying Holy Scripture. This year I have been learning Hebrew and Greek to be able to read the Bible in its original languages. Looking forward to meet you, I say goodbye for now. God bless you.
