



The Body and Blood of Christ 7th June 2015 (p. 85 of Mass book)

Today we celebrate Corpus Christi when the Church asks us to reflect on the great Gift of the Eucharist which is the Presence of Jesus under the form of Bread and Wine - the Presence which puts us in touch with the Life, Passion, Death and Resurrection of the Lord. Love beyond measure gathers us, nourishes us and empowers us to be servants of the Good News of Jesus Christ - Apostles!

One name we often use for the celebration is 'Mass' which comes from the Latin dismissal at the end: 'Ite, missa est!' These words are pregnant with so many layers of meaning: 'The Mass has happened', 'Go - you are sent out.'; the translation into English is difficult because nothing can quite encapsulate the sense in Latin! However, what is clear is that the Mass is dynamic, sacred and Divine; it is an Act of Worship instigated by Jesus Christ who in turn helps us to offer the Father the very best which is Jesus himself. The Spirit which comes upon the Bread and Wine, transforming them into the Lord himself is also poured out on each one of us uniting us, strengthening us and sending us forth to carry on the Lord's work. What is celebrated and proclaimed in the church must be lived out in the every day. Wow!

Today's Solemnity importantly invites us to try and grasp the fact that we believe that the Bread and Wine are truly Jesus' Body and Blood. So, the Son of God who is the Second Person of the Trinity allows us to taste of his very Life. Jesus who died and rose is presence in this significant way so that our reception of Holy Communion is an amazing experience as we are put in touch with such deep, sacrificial Love. As we incorporate Jesus into our very being by receiving him, he incorporates us into his Life so that we can become like him! Hence reverence, devotion and awe are crucial as we demonstrate our belief in the Transformation which takes place in the Eucharist.

Let us thank God for this great Gift left to us by his Son. Let us pray that today's Mass will serve to deepen our faith and be poured out in loving service in the coming week.. God bless you. ***Fr. Norbert***

David Krupa will be ordained a deacon in St. Denis on Saturday 24th October. They will be in WGC the first week of September possibly with Remy Pignal from St. Denis. The Archdiocese of Seville has asked us to take two Spanish seminarians in July and so the international Church will continue to make its impact on our Garden City!
