## ***23<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of the Year 4<sup>th</sup> September 2022***

**RESPONSES TO CONSULTATION** More responses have come in over the summer and we hope to have by next week a short summary of parishioners' views on the possible merger of our three parishes. This should be ready by next weekend which will give a chance for further reflection and more views to be expressed in time for the Parish Meeting on Wednesday 28th September at 8pm in the new Trinity Hall (we hope). On 28th September the more detailed report will be available for discussion and result in a final draft to be sent to the Cardinal. Each one of you is so important in this consultation process. We need MANY of you to come to the meeting!

**FINANCE COMMITTEE** Our Lady's Finance Committee will meet on Tuesday 6th September at 7.45pm.

**SUPPLY PRIESTS** Monsignor Harry Turner, Fr. Stephen Coker and Fr. Frank Leonard are helping us with some Sundays and a few weekdays. It is good to have their support and we know they will be warmly welcomed!

**CERTIFICATE OF CATHOLICTY** Some of our Catholic Schools require the Parish Priest to provide a Certificate of Catholicity for entry to Primary or Secondary School. In due course Fr. Norbert will publish how this will be done. However, he wants to emphasise that attendance at Mass is a requirement. Covid has placed many burdens on individuals, families and households; now is the time to do your best to return regularly to church. Children can only get here if they are brought by their families. Thank you.

**SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION** for First Confession, First Holy Communion and Confirmation will start after Christmas. Soon we will ask parents to enrol their children for Communion and young people to enrol for Confirmation. We will let you know when the application Forms are on the website. Also, if any adults would like to be catechists for these Sacraments, please let Fr. Norbert know. There would be training and all the necessary safeguarding guidelines would have to be followed.

**RCIA** The Rite of the Christian Initiation of Adults for adults who would like to join the Catholic Church will start on Monday 7th November at 7.30pm in the Sacristy of Our Lady's. There are a number who have made themselves known. If you are interested please speak to Fr. Norbert. This is also a great way for adults, who missed out on Confirmation when they were younger, to prepare for Confirmation. In some countries you cannot get married in the Catholic Church if not confirmed.
