'Habemus Papam!' These were the words we finally heard after the white smoke issued from the chimney of the Sistine Chapel last Wednesday. And after another wait we caught sight of our new Holy Father - Pope Francis I. I have been struck by the warmth, humility and charm of this Pontiff who spans continents, languages and customs in terms of his experience. Little did I know last week when in Rome that the future Pope was staying in the same hotel as me and my companions! We are told he went back after being elected to pay his bill and collect his luggage.

As Catholics we hold the firm conviction that the election of a pope is guided by the Holy Spirit. Let us be generous in our intercession on his behalf and for the Church as the Gospel is proclaimed and lived out in every part of the world.

We have to get back to Lent, don't we?! Today's Gospel reminds us of how generous Jesus Christ is with his mercy and how challenging he is with us in our attitudes. There was no way that he would throw a stone at the sinner caught in the act. Rather he forgives and sends her away in peace. Surely that is what we ask of him? Whether it is the big things that weigh on our consciences or those small sins which seem insurmountable, he is always waiting patiently for us to come to him, to talk to him and to hear the power of reconciling love. May God support our Lenten efforts this week.
