Fifth Sunday of Easter (page 271) 24th April 2016

'I give you a new commandment: love one another; just as I have loved you, you also must love one another. By this love you have for one another, everyone will know that you are my disciples.'

These are the last sentences of the Gospel passage today taken from St. John's account of the Last Supper. At the heart of Jesus' instruction is love. We must love in the way that we are loved. We must reveal that we are disciples of Jesus through our mutual love.

Let us reflect on 'love'. In St. John's Gospel we hear in the Prologue that the Word became Flesh and lived among us and that the Son who is closest to the Father's heart has made him known. At the Last Supper the Beloved Disciple reclines next to Jesus; he is so close to Jesus, he will be there at the foot of the Cross with Our Lady and he sets down in writing the Gospel which puts us in touch with Jesus. Where do *we* find ourselves in the love flowing from Father to Son to Beloved?

When Jesus dies on the Cross he pours out love which is sacrificial. He dies in obedience to the Father and he gives himself for *us* that we may receive forgiveness and that heaven may be our destiny. As we open up ourselves to the Lord, allowing sacrificial love into our hearts, we need to consider the ways in which Jesus wants us to make sacrifices for others and for God our Father - to let the Word become flesh in us!

Jesus speaks of a New Commandment. We can often be resistant to being asked or told to do something! Maybe it is pride? Perhaps at times we think we know what to do anyway? Jesus was obedient to his Father because he knew it was the right thing to do and he trusted his Father. He wants us to kindle in our lives a desire to listen to his command and respond. To be beloved disciples close to Jesus' heart and moulding our hearts on his. Let us pray for this grace this week. God bless you. *Fr. Norbert*

AYLESFORD Parish Pilgrimage for the Year of Mercy to Aylesford, Kent on Saturday 14th May. Aylesford Priory, or 'The Friars' to give it its traditional name, was founded in 1242 when the first Carmelites arrived from the Holy Land. They came under the patronage of Richard de Grey, a crusader, who gave them a small piece of land at his manor of Aylesford. In 1247 the Bishop of Rochester, Richard of Wendover, officially recognised the Carmelite foundation at Aylesford and the first General Chapter of the Order outside the Holy Land was held there. Now in this Jubilee Year of Mercy 2016, we are going as pilgrims to the same place! The caoch will leave Our Lady's at 9am. There will the RosaryWay at Aylesford, picnic lunch (bring all you need!), Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and Mass. We should be back by 6pm. The cost will be £10 for adults and £5 for children.
