

Thirty-third Sunday of the Year 19th November 2017 p. 155 of Mass book

We are nearly at the end of the Church's Year and on the verge of a new one! As we approach the concluding sections of St. Matthew's Gospel, we are given today a parable of trust: God's trust in us by entrusting us with so much - in and through our Christian faith - and our trust in God by making good use of his gift to us. The sad case of the last servant in the parable, who was afraid of his master and not prepared to take a risk with the huge sum of money, shows a mean-spirited attitude towards a God of tender love and compassion. This story highlights the fact that God's desire is for us to experience life through the Gospel and share its blessings with others so that it continues to blossom and flourish in our own day. If this 'Good News' is buried within us as a private matter or is put on hold with the 'pause' button, its effect is stifled. In St. Matthew's Gospel, we have had impressed on us the fact that, in Jesus, God is with us. This should leave us with a joy so infectious that others can sense our faith from the way we live and cope with the challenges of life.

On Wednesday 37 of us will be setting off for the Holy Land. We will start in Jerusalem and then go up to Galilee. At every step, we will be praying for you; please remember us and ask God to watch over us so that we will be safe. My hope is that many blessings will come to our town through this ecumenical pilgrimage, that when we return, the bonds of love, prayer and fellowship will radiate out to others. A Bible is so important on a pilgrimage like this: reading Scripture in a place associated with the Lord brings the text to life and keeps you focused on what really matters. Walking, talking, eating and drinking, praying and moments of worship, silent contemplation as well as celebrating Mass will hold us together in a powerful way and bring joy and energy. It is not possible to follow the events of Jesus' life in the right order; so we will be with him in Gethsemane on Thursday before we go to Bethlehem on Friday! However, I am sure we'll get our heads round that. May God bless you all. Shalom! *Fr. Norbert*
