

Second Sunday of Advent 10th December 2017 p. 85 of Mass book

In the last few days we have heard the term 'the end of the beginning' in regard to *Brexit*! There have been negotiations, agreements, disagreements, fresh approaches, shuttle diplomacy and all that! What we do know is that we are not close to a settlement but that some light is shining out in the darkness. The journey will be a long one but an arrival date has been set.

I was thinking about this on Friday as I pondered today's Gospel reading from St. Mark: 'The beginning of the Good News about Jesus Christ, the Son of God.' Jesus Christ IS Good News. He came at a particular time and in a specific place. His words and actions intimate God's presence in our midst, especially his Death and Resurrection. He will return in glory at the time appointed by God the Father. God, through the ministry of his prophets and his relationship with his Chosen People, prepared them for the Coming of his Son. John the Baptist, in particular, was given the task of being the final Voice summoning people to a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins. John's activity by the River Jordan would point those gathered towards the One who would baptise with the Holy Spirit.

In Jesus something new has begun *and is still happening*! Each year in Advent we join the hordes waiting by the River Jordan and we prepare ourselves for Christ. What is it this year in our lives which requires the healing power of God's reconciling love? What has gone wrong? Where is there confusion and darkness? What are the obstacles? We are told in the quote from Isaiah in the Gospel passage that we should make God's paths straight - what might help? Extra prayer, the Sacrament of Reconciliation, reaching out to people in need and less fortunate than ourselves, finding space just to 'be' and experience God. John the Baptist says that Jesus will baptise us with the Holy Spirit - what does that mean for you? Perhaps a strengthening of your bond with Christ or an extra effort to be more like him?

As we start this second week in Advent, let us pray for an opening to even more of God's grace revealed in his Son Jesus. Who knows what will happen?! *Fr. Norbert*

The Government is making a critical decision on whether to overturn the admissions cap which prevents Catholic schools from allowing all Catholic pupils to attend. They have acknowledged that this policy discriminates against Catholics and promised to abandon it; now we need you to tell them not to u-turn on their promise to Catholics.
