

How has your summer been? Do feel ready for another year? I began my holidays in Romania in Bacau visiting Fr. Marius Cojan who came to WGC last year. He made sure I had time to rest and planned a number of things to give me a taste of the Church in his country. As many of you know, my younger brother Francis had a massive heart attack that week; so I flew back to London to be with him and his wife. I really thought I might be coming back to a Funeral as he wasn't breathing for 12 minutes. An off-duty policeman gave him CPR and kept him going. An air-ambulance took him to hospital. Francis is now at home resting and recovering from all that took place. He is aware that so many of you here in Welwyn Garden City were praying for him and he is so grateful. After that I had some days of retreat, as planned, in Arundel with the Poor Clares. It truly was a time of refreshment and closeness to the Lord. Then off to Dublin for the World Meeting of Families - a wonderful experience with thousands from every nation gathered to reflect on Family Life with its challenges and joys. Now I have been back a week and am gradually getting back into the routine, catching up with messages and preparing for the next weeks and months.

I hope to be able to share with you some of the points from Dublin. There was also a presentation about young people and the forthcoming Synod of Bishops which will look at the place of young people in the Church and the world. The process of preparation and collaboration was also explained. It was fascinating! This too should, I think, be a priority for us here. Next weekend thousands will go to Liverpool from all over England and Wales for the Eucharistic Congress called *Adoremus*. The treasure of the Eucharist bequeathed to the Church by Christ defines who we are and supports us in all that we do. Our aspiration is to bring back to our parishes insights, teaching and ideas to strengthen our understanding. Please pray for all who will be attending.

Norbert will in due course publish dates to meet up with children and their parents/guardians to fill out the relevant forms. It is crucial to read a school's admissions policy to see if your child has a good chance of getting in.

RCIA Are you interested in joining the Catholic Church or knowing more? Are you a Catholic adult who missed out on Confirmation when you were younger? Now's the time to think about the next steps! Pray. Talk to another Catholic. Come to Church and deepen your experience of being with others. The first session for our three parishes will be on Monday 1st October at 7.30pm in Our Lady's Sacristy.
