

Fifth Sunday of Lent 7th April page 176 of the Mass Book

In February 2016, Pope Francis asked each Bishops' Conference to establish a Day of Prayer for Survivors of Abuse. In response, the Bishops of England and Wales designated the Friday of the Fifth Week of Lent to be observed as this Day of Prayer. This year, therefore, the Day of Prayer is Friday 12th April.

Cardinal Vincent Nichols writes: I ask that this Day of Prayer is observed in all our parishes and chapels. It is important that we do so. Day by day, the pain of those who have suffered abuse, and its lasting corrosive impact, are brought more fully into the light. The pain of that betrayal of trust is all the more profound when the abuse took place within the community of the Catholic Church. We also see so clearly the failures in leadership in the Church that have exacerbated the sufferings of those who have been abused.

We have plenty of reasons to pray:

We pray for those who bear this pain. We pray for their strength and perseverance.

We pray for those who have been caught up in the circles of mistrust, silence and complicity which emanate from this abuse.

We seek repentance and renewal for all who have failed in their duty to protect and respond to the victims of these crimes.

We pray for a renewal in the life of our Church that has become a lodging place for this evil.

We pray in confidence that the Lord does not abandon His Church but constantly calls us to purify our ways of life.

We pray with Mary, our holy Mother, and finest expression of our Holy Mother, the Church.

Here in Welwyn Garden City we will reflect these intentions in the Stations of the Cross on Friday both in the morning after 9.30 Mass at St. Bonaventure's and at Our Lady's after 7pm Mass. The Restoration Holy Hour will be filled with a spirit of peace, healing and hope. Please pray that day and come to what is possible. Thank you.

WALSINGHAM This year on Saturday 18th May, we will have a coach going to Walsingham in Norfolk. The Shrine dates back to 1061 and has been a place of pilgrimage for centuries. It is always a glorious day and we have the joy of joining the National Deaf Pilgrimage. We will leave from Our Lady's Church at 8am, arriving in time for a Service in the village at 12 noon. Fr. Norbert has been asked to lead this Service and the 'signing group' from WGC will help with the signed hymns. We will then walk the Holy Mile into the Catholic Shrine. There'll be a picnic lunch (please bring food and drink!), Mass and time to visit the Slipper Chapel, cream tea or ice-creams and we'll depart at 5pm. Please fill out a form available at the back of our churches to secure a place on the coach. Price £15 adults and £10 for children.

FIRST COMMUNION RETREAT DAY Just to remind the First Communion families that they have their Afternoon Retreat at St. Albans on Sunday 28th April starting at 12.30pm. First Communion Masses will be on Sundays as follows: Our Lady's 12th May and 9th June at 11.30am, Holy Family 19th May 12 noon and St. Bonaventure's 16th June at 10.30am.

NEW PARISH CENTRE A pre-contract meeting took place during the week and it looks as though all systems are go! The builders should take possession of the site on Monday 29th April and the demolition of the old hall will follow. The project should take 12 'working' months, so our new Parish Centre would be ready by summer 2020. To get ready for the April date, we will need to have many helping hands to prepare items for storage and muscle to take things up the church tower into the rooms for safe keeping for the next year. On Friday 26th April at 11am, we are looking for volunteers to help wrap up glasses etc and box them up. On the same day from 6.30pm, we will move these boxes and furniture which is to be kept into the tower rooms. If you can help in any way, please let Fr. Norbert know. After that, whatever is left will be open to being taken by parishioners. Specific times will be published.

There will be Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament for 30 minutes on Mondays at Our Lady's (after 9.30 Mass), Thursdays at Holy Family (after 9.30 Mass) and Saturdays at St. Bonaventure's (after 10am Mass). There will be the Restoration Holy Hour at Our Lady's this Friday (12th) after Stations of the Cross (around 8pm). The Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession) will be as usual on Thursdays at Holy Family (10.00 - 10.30am), Saturdays at St. Bonaventure's (10.30 - 11.00am) and at Our Lady's (5.00 - 5.30pm). The main Service of Reconciliation for Welwyn Garden City will be in Holy Week on Tuesday 16th April at 8pm at Our Lady's.

PALM SUNDAY Any children who wish to take part in the Passion at the 11.30 Palm Sunday Mass on 14th April at Our Lady's should come to a practice the previous day (Saturday 13th) at 11am
