

What a contrast we have in our lengthy Gospel passage today from St. Luke with Jesus' three parables of the 'Lost and Found'! We are told firstly that the scribes and Pharisees complain that Jesus welcomes sinners and eats with them. All Jesus can respond with is a set of stories which are filled with the sheer delight of people who find what/who was lost: a shepherd his sheep, a woman her coin and a father his son. To Jesus' audience it is scandalous that he should invite people, who are known to be sinners, to be with him and that he shares food with them. Would they contaminate him by their talk, their experiences, the company they might bring along too?! Surely they responded to the invitation because they recognised he wanted them to be there and that he had a message-in-person to deliver - a God who reverses the fortunes of so many is ready to forgive and offers a fresh start. Those who grumble begrudge the Lord's generous love and a mercy which is munificent.

As we respond to Christ's invitation to the Eucharistic Banquet, we come in need of God's love, forgiveness and healing. We have gathered with a multitude of humanity who are on the way but haven't yet made it. We draw strength from God's Son who does not turn anyone away but lovingly calls each one into an intimacy where he or she can realise their importance in God's eyes and the gift of salvation from Jesus' Cross and Resurrection which makes up for what is lacking in our lives. What we experience here in this Church setting, we are challenged to live out in the everyday: persevering, being agents of reconciliation, open to others as the Lord has welcomed us. It is not easy but it is a joy for us just as God's delight overflows in abundance when we turn back to him humbly and feel his embrace.

Today the Cardinal is in our midst for Our Lady's 60th Anniversary. May it be a moment of blessing for our whole community. Have a great week!

OUR LADY'S 60TH Today we welcome Cardinal Vincent Nichols to Our Lady's to mark the 60th Anniversary of the Foundation Stone. We give thanks for all the people and priests who generously gave of themselves to finance and realise the building of the church and who have over the last 60 years created a community of warmth and welcome.

CONFIRMATION ENROLMENT There will be a meeting for young people who wish to be confirmed next year (they must be at least in Year 9 at secondary school) on Sunday 6th October 7pm in Holy Family Church. Parents also are asked to come to the meeting. The meeting will last about an hour.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION ENROLMENT There will be meetings as follows: St. Bonaventure's on Saturday 5th October at 11am (1st session Saturday 19th October), Our Lady's on Tuesday 19th November at 7.45pm and Holy Family on Sunday 1st December after 9.30am Mass. Children for First Communion should be at least in Year 3 at Primary School.

Preparation for children at St. Bonaventure's is monthly on a Saturday morning, at Our Lady's after Christmas before 11.30 Mass on Sundays and at Holy Family after Christmas on Wednesdays after school. There will also be joint parents' meetings on Wednesday evenings after Christmas.

DO YOU WANT TO BECOME A CATHOLIC? Have you got lots of questions? Does now seem like the right time? Is someone close to you encouraging you to take the first step? The Rite of the Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is a wonderful way of preparing, reflecting and meeting others in the same boat, supported by great catechists! Their prayers were answered and the first Passion Play was performed in 1634.

This event is being organised by the borough council in conjunction with the local inter faith group.
