Third and Fourth Sundays of Advent 15th December pages 88/91 of book

On the Third Sunday of Advent, we hear from Isaiah: 'Do not be afraid.' St James tells his community: 'Be patient...do not lose heart.' St. John the Baptist sends messengers to ask Jesus: 'Are you the one?' How do these words from Scripture resonate in your mind and heart as we reach an important milestone in the Advent Season? We're over the half-way mark! The Church cries out 'Gaudete! Rejoice!' Is that how you feel? What are the things in your personal life, in society or further afield which make you afraid? Is it hard to be patient because your prayers have not yet been answered or the response was baffling? Do you at times, like the Baptist, wonder if it all really is true and Jesus is the Messiah, the Saviour of the world? Isaiah speaks of a time when creation will be renewed and the downtrodden and suffering of humanity will be lifted up. James writes about the farmer who exhibits great patience in carrying out his work. Jesus just asks the messengers to report what they have heard and what they have seen - it IS Good News! It does take faith and trust; it requires looking and understanding, listening and perceiving. That is our task and responsibility as we prepare ourselves and the world for the Lord's coming.

On the Fourth Sunday of Advent, with Christmas imminent, we have in our Gospel reading the picture of Joseph receiving a message in a dream that Mary will conceive a child through the Holy Spirit and that his name will be Jesus - the one who will save the people from their sins; Isaiah's prophetic words are quoted which refer to the child who will be Emmanuel - God-with-us. St. Matthew simply tells us that Joseph did what the Lord had told him to do. We are preparing to encounter God intimately close to us in a baby; this child will bring us salvation. God wants us to carry out his will. This can sometimes be challenging in the circumstances we face; however, the Lord is close to us and in the midst of complications, his grace breaks through. So do not worry!

However and wherever you celebrate the coming Feast, I pray that it will be a time of blessing for you and your loved ones. May God reveal his presence anew, strengthening you in faith and love. Thank you for all you do to make our community open and vibrant, one that reaches out. May new parishioners enjoy their first Christmas in Welwyn Garden City and may visitors be enriched by these special moments in our midst. For those travelling to be with family or friends elsewhere, have a wonderful time and come back safely. God bless you. ***Fr. Norbert***
