

First Sunday of Lent 1st March page 151 of Mass book

It's March and Lent has begun! Time is racing by with the year progressing and much to be thought about and reflected on in this holy season. As many of you are aware 'time' in the Bible can mean *days* and years ('chronos') - the passage of time as we count it. However, there is another word 'kairos' - meaning a moment or opportunity to be seized and acted upon. Sometimes we just seem to be running out of time to get things done. Lent is a series of invitations to us to be open to God's life-giving and transformative grace so that we might become more and more like Jesus: through forgiveness and reconciliation, by fasting and making sacrifices, in the efforts to do extra things which can make a difference to ourselves and so many others. Prayer, generous giving and learning to say 'no' to temptation can put us in touch with Jesus Christ, God's Son, in his 40-day sojourn in the desert...not always easy!

In our passage today from St. Matthew, we see Christ preparing for his public ministry with a long period of temptation and testing in the desert. We cannot help but think of the People of Israel journey through the desert for 40 years, giving in to many temptations as they make their way from slavery to freedom in the Promised Land. They were hungry and grumbled frequently at the manna God gave them to eat; Jesus refuses to turn stones into bread to assuage his hunger, preferring to live by God's Word. They put God to the test asking 'Is God in our midst or not? (Exodus 17); Jesus trusts totally in his Father and will not throw himself off the parapet of the Temple - he knows his Father is with him. They gave up on God (and Moses when he went up the mountain) and chose to worship the Golden Calf; Jesus says that worship is for God alone.

Perhaps this week we might ponder some of the challenges Jesus faced. What makes us frustrated and angry with God and others in our lives? What makes us lose patience and feel like giving up? Do we really believe God is in our midst? What helps or hinders that understanding? Are there things which have taken over our lives to such an extent that the Lord is being pushed out of the way? These are many questions and it is not as easy to face up to the truth and change our ways for a whole variety of reasons.

Let us pray for God's grace. Let us not forget the multitude of people around the world and closer to home who are suffering. Let us seize the moment and make the right choices day by day! May God bless your week. *Fr. Norbert*

LENT During Lent there will be Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament for half an hour on a Monday after 9.30 Mass at Our Lady's (except 9th March), on a Thursday after 9.30 Mass at Holy Family and on a Saturday after 10am Mass at St. Bonaventure's. There will be Stations of the Cross on a Wednesday after 9.30 Mass at Holy Family, on a Friday after 9.30 Mass at St. Bonaventure's and on a Friday after 7pm Mass at Our Lady's (except 13th March). The Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession) will be available on Thursdays at Holy Family Church 10.00 - 10.30am and on Saturdays - at St. Bonaventure's 10.30 - 11.00am and at Our Lady's 5.00 - 5.30pm. There will be priests also available at Our Lady's on Friday 20th March after Stations of the Cross and the Holy Week Service on Tuesday 7th April at 8pm at Our Lady's. Don't forget the First Friday early morning Masses at St. Bonaventure's at 6.30 followed by breakfast (6th March and 3rd April).
