

# 5th Sunday of the Year 5th February

In our Second Reading today from St. Paul's First Letter to the Corinthians, he speaks to the community about 'a demonstration of the power of the Spirit.' When you read those words or hear them, how do you imagine what the Apostle is referring to? In the Acts of the Apostles given to us by St. Luke, the Spirit is made known through noise, tongues of flame and many languages. In St. John's Gospel, the Spirit is the breath of Jesus, a breeze blowing where it will. In the Hebrew Scriptures Elijah encounters God in a still small voice - almost a whisper. I think that this power of the Spirit is about communication - God with us and our openness to him; our attention to the Presence and his yearning to enrich us. Paul feels called to be an instrument and carries this out with his whole being. The Apostles were entrusted with a special mission by Christ and handed on their first-hand experience of the words and actions of the Lord. They tried to use language as a mode of conveying truths which were deep and mystical; they relied on the Holy Spirit to be the driving force behind their teaching.

What about us in our period of history and in the places where we live? Jesus has something profound to say to us in today's Gospel passage from St. Matthew! YOU are salt...YOU are light! There's no beating about the bush with Christ - he looks at his disciples and he knows he can count on them. He spends time with them and they, in turn, can change the world, giving glory to God in the process. How do you feel about the fact that the Lord has such confidence in you? Our homes, our places of work, our schools and our streets can and should become grace-filled crucibles of loving encounter because we have taken the trouble to let the Lord be seen through us. Amazing! Don't leave it to someone else. Let your whole being radiate him who is Emmanuel - God-with-us.

I would like to say a personal 'Thank you' to everyone who has expressed kind words and encouraged me given that Tuesday's installation is imminent. Lots of you have told me you hope to be there. Obviously, it's a long way into London and circumstances might prevent many from attending. However, the strength of your prayer is a demonstration to me of the power of the Spirit and a feeling of closeness we share in our Christian Community. I am fortunate to have you and a multitude of others to support me. God bless you.
