2nd Sunday of Lent 5th March

Every Second Sunday of Lent, the Church takes us up a high mountain with Jesus and a few of his disciples to be alone. We are given the vision of Jesus in glory flanked by Elijah and Moses who also appear. A voice is heard and Jesus is designated as the Father's Beloved who enjoys his favour. All are asked to listen to him. Suddenly they are on their own again and come back down the mountain. Jesus orders them not to tell anyone about the event until he has risen from the dead. This is the Transfiguration!

Lent is our time to be spent with the Lord. At times we experience special moments when we feel the intimacy and power of divine presence. Perhaps also we can find ourselves in the shadow of a cloud, not knowing what to think or what to say. During Lent through the sacred works we undertake, we can feel God's Spirit working in and through us in ways we never thought possible. In addition, Lent prompts us to consider when it all goes horribly wrong and we need to confess our weakness and throw ourselves into God's arms of mercy. The Transfiguration points towards the glory Jesus will win through his Cross and gives us a glimpse of the glory God has in store for us.

These same disciples will be close to Jesus in the Garden on the night before he dies. The Lord will ask them to pray with him. They will fall asleep! We have this 40-day period to prepare ourselves for Gethsemane, to pray for the energy to stay with Jesus every step of the way. Let us ask the Lord to consecrate what we have begun and to let it bear fruit for his Passion, Death and Resurrection.
