

HOLY FAMILY

5th Sunday of Lent 26th March

Today we are taken to a tomb in Bethany, just outside Jerusalem, where amazing things happen. Jesus has lost his friend Lazarus. Martha and then later Mary speak to Jesus and include the poignant words 'If only you had been here...' Imagine how Jesus feels with his own personal grief as well as facing the sadness of his friends. St. John tells us that Jesus weeps - he is human! He is also divine and the power of his word crying 'Lazarus, here! Come out!' results in the extraordinary 'sign' of the Lord's friend emerging from the tomb, still wrapped in the linen cloths. People believe in Jesus as they witness what God is doing through him; others will seek to destroy Lazarus because he becomes a reason for many to follow Jesus. The crowds have to make a decision!

In two weeks' time we will be at a different tomb; this time the Lord himself is inside. Through the power of the Holy Spirit, the dead body of Jesus is raised to the glory of Resurrection. He is not brought back to the former life he lived - as happened to Lazarus. Jesus Christ emerges with a 'new' body - similar and yet different, recognisable yet elusive. This is a really challenging dimension of Christian Faith! Principally this is due to our conviction that the Resurrection of the Body is something that we hold will happen to us when the Lord is ready on the Last Day. Our bodies are precious, temples of the Holy Spirit and bear the stamp of the Creator. Our identity comes from our souls/spirits AND bodies. When the Last Day comes, God will find a way of uniting our souls/spirits with 'risen' glorified bodies. In the Book of the Apocalypse, we read about a New Heaven and a New Earth; we will be a part of this New Creation! Wow! What do you think you will look like? feel like? How will your love for God and others be echoed for eternity in the Presence of the Trinity of Love? Very hard to explain but crucial in the articulation of faith expressed in the hope of eternal love. When we encounter death in the person of a loved one, let us reflect on, and consider, the enormity of what it means to pray that they too with Christ will rise from the dead with a glorified body through the grace of the Lord's Death and Resurrection. As Jesus says to Martha: 'I am the Resurrection and the Life', he asks her as he asks us 'Do you believe this?' What is your response?

Let us pray for one another as Lent proceeds to its culmination in Holy Week and especially in the Sacred Triduum. God bless you. With much love, *Fr. Norbert*
