
WELWYN GARDEN CITY



Fifth Sunday of Easter 7th May 2023

I remember my first visit to Welwyn Garden City when appointed as Parish Priest back in 2008. I came off the A1 motorway near Holy Family Church and had a quick look! I then drove over the White Bridge and was overwhelmed by the sight of the town centre in all its glory with the sun shining and the Coronation Fountain glistening. I made my way past St. Bonaventure's and then found Our Lady's where Fr. Peter Maher made me very welcome. He showed me kindness and gave me encouragement in the task of taking on the three parishes (as they were then). Sadly, with his death, the clergy associated with WGC at the time of my arrival have all now gone before us: Fr. Bill McConalogue, Fr. John McCoy, Fr. Joe Boward and now Fr. Peter. May they all rest in the glory of heaven.

Just think that the Coronation Fountain has been spouting water for the last 70 years! Those who designed it made it look like a crown and the water flowing creates a vital, life-giving sign. I wonder if , back in 1953, anyone thought that this icon would play such an important part in marking out the centre of Welwyn Garden City. Kingship is not static and certainly needs to be renewed in every age. Our living here in WGC, whether or not we came more recently or have lived here for a huge length of time is determined by the spirit of this Garden City and those whose vision resulted in such beauty. Let each one of us work for the Kingdom which Jesus inaugurated!

In our Gospel passage from St. John, we have moved to the Last Supper Discourse and hear Jesus speaking with conviction about his origins with the Father. To see Jesus is to be put in touch with his Father. We are signs to others of the amazing power of God made manifest in his disciples. Let us rise to this challenge!

The donation must come from a bank account in the name of the taxpayer who is claiming Gift Aid which can be a joint account.

It has now become once more the National Shrine of Our Lady in this country. The coach will leave from Our Lady's at 8am and depart from Walsingham around 4.30pm (arriving back around 7pm).
