Trinity Sunday 4th June 2023

We are now back in Ordinary Time though our Sundays have some important celebrations. Today the Church invites us to consider and give thanks for God who is a Trinity of Persons and yet One. This Mystery is pivotal to our Christian Faith AND is difficult to explain fully! God from all eternity has existed: Father pouring out love upon the Son with the Son returning that love and the dynamism between the two being the Holy Spirit. This foundational triune relationship then flows into Creation culminating in the creation of humanity and the Incarnation with the Son becoming flesh as one of us. God's generosity has resulted in our experience of his Presence in our midst and the invitation to join this Trinity of Persons one day in the glory and wonder of heaven. Then we will see and truly know the Trinity!

Our Scripture passages today express in variety of ways the marvels of who God is. From Exodus: 'a God of tenderness and compassion, slow to anger, rich in kindness and faithfulness'. From St. Paul's Second Letter to the Corinthians: 'the God of love and peace'. From St. John's Gospel: 'God loved the world so much that he gave his only Son.' We are called into this life and, in turn, to share this love with others. God understands when we do not always get it right and God forgives, offering a fresh start. The Cross and Resurrection are the source of reconciliation.

A week ago, I had the opportunity to visit Rome for a few days. My main purpose was to catch up with friends, some of whom have come to Welwyn Garden City. Talking, listening, celebrating and praying were key elements of my time there. I met the two Spanish priests who will be coming this summer and they are very excited as the prospect of spending time in our churches. There were also moments when the languages being used were Italian and Spanish and so I had to focus on people's facial expressions and hand gestures to read what was going on! Last Saturday my older brother celebrated his 60th birthday with a James Bond themed party. Many family members were there as well as his friends and there was a brilliant experience of a togetherness which no-one wanted to end when the celebration concluded. The Trinity calls upon us to enter into its family life and rejoice in its friendship. Heaven will be a banquet for eternity as well as contemplation of the pure Love which is God!
