
WELWYN GARDEN CITY



22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time 3rd September 2023

A new year, a new month and many changes. Firstly, I hope all of you have enjoyed the summer as a time of refreshment even if the sun has not shone constantly. For those still waiting for your break, I trust it will come speedily. Since I returned from my time away, I have been struck by the number of visitors in our midst at Mass, many of whom are not from a Catholic background. There is a real thirst to discover more, to deepen understanding of who Christ is and his impact on our personal lives as well as the world. This weekend we ask God's blessing on Fr. William and Kathryn Hubbard as each begins a new chapter in their lives. Soon we will welcome Fr. Marco as Assistant Priest and Jacqui Boon as Parish Administrator.

In our Gospel reading from St. Matthew, the focus is on Jesus teaching his disciples about his Passion, Death and Resurrection - the Cross! The Lord invites us to take up our crosses and follow him. In between these two sections Simon Peter looms, trying to dissuade Jesus from embracing the cause he has accepted. Peter - the stone and the rock on which the Church is built - becomes a stumbling block in the Lord's pathway. His role is to walk behind, following the Lord, rather than telling Jesus what not to do! How relevant for everyone as a new year begins! We have talents, gifts and skills which can be put at the service of the world, including our fellow human beings. We have the capacity to build the Kingdom of heaven here on earth! What do you see in yourself? Ask the Lord to guide you as you reach out to others. Don't put things off for another year!
