In our Second Reading from St. Paul to the Philippians, the Apostle writes about Community and he presents the essence of Jesus Christ as God and Man. We discover vocabulary to underpin our identity as Christians: love, tenderness, sympathy, unity, a willingness to be self-effacing (modest) and to think of others' interests. This is all prefaced by 'If our life in Christ means anything to you.' Paul then proceeds to outline how Christ Jesus from his place with God (the Father) let go of everything in order to become one of us. He came down to us and then was hung on a Cross. God however raised him high and has given him a name to be worshipped and adored. Paul wants us as Community, a fellowship of persons, to mirror the dynamic we discover in Jesus Christ so that one day we might live for ever in this beauty and majesty in God's presence - heaven!

This week the RCIA begins in our parish. Let us pray for all who feel called to join the Church or to find out more. Let us pray also for those who consider now the right time to complete their initiation into the Catholic Church through Confirmation. It is a big step to take and requires a new beginning and the feeling of the support of the Community. Our faith is in Jesus Christ, God and Human Being. Our belief is in a God who is a Trinity of Persons. At the heart of our worship as Catholic Christians is the reality of Bread and Wine becoming the Body and Blood of the Lord Jesus who helps us to worship God the Father in the power of the Holy Spirit.

We must not forget that we are then sent out with a message and a way of life which should be in harmony with one another. That is what St. Paul exhorts the Church in Philippi to carry out. What a joy! What a challenge! For us too here in Welwyn Garden City and beyond! God bless you. With my love and prayers, *Fr. Norbert*
