'You must love God and your neighbour!' These words form the essence of today's Gospel passage from St. Matthew. I think that it is so important to see the context in which the Lord utters them. Firstly there are the groups trying to silence Jesus with a line of questioning to confound him. As we saw last week, the Lord has just the right way of responding to them! Now it is the case of the 'greatest commandment of the Law' and Jesus speaks of love of God with your whole being and love of neighbour; he adds that on these two 'hang the whole Law and the Prophets also'.

Another context I would like to reflect on is the positioning of this episode in the Gospel. We are coming to the end of St. Matthew with Jesus having already entered Jerusalem on a donkey. Soon he will be taken to the Cross and pour our his life in Sacrifice for humanity. As Jesus speaks today's words, he cannot have helped but pondered on what this *love* would be like in his own life. He definitely loves the Father with his whole being - he has experienced love from eternity and now it reaches its climax. This love is for the sake of the human race, to bring salvation and offer an alternative experience to us of what it means to be loved by our God-in-Jesus. How fortunate and blessed we are!

Finally, as we read today's passage, we think about the context of the Holy Land at the present moment. Love is needed for reconciliation. Love overcomes evil. Love heals the pain of bereavement. Love can overcome so much as is evidenced in Jesus' Life, Death and Resurrection. Let us, in love, pray so hard for the situation as it continues to unfold. May our hope be in the power of God to overcome the barriers which humanly speaking seem unsurmountable.
