With bereavement, there is that gap in one's heart, life and routine. So many places and experiences are the constant reminder of a loved one. There are the fresh things hap-pening in life which you just want to share and then it hits home that they are no longer at the other end of a phone. Loss needs healing and patience. Sadness cannot be blown away. There are so many ways of dealing with grief and it is crucial to take time.
