

First Sunday of Advent 2nd December 2012 (page 82)

Last Thursday Bishop John Sherrington invited the clergy of Hertfordshire to have a Day of Recollection. We gathered at the Niland Centre in Bushey and, as well as catching up with others, we had time for quiet, prayerful reflection and two talks given by the Bishop. It seems strange that nowadays we need to have time to prepare for a time of preparation! Advent requires space, thought and planning. I was eager on Thursday to find some fresh insights and pointers to guide me through the Season of Advent.

Something I discovered from Bishop John is that in the Middles Ages the Gospel reading for the First Sunday of Advent was taken from Jesus' Triumphal Entry into Jerusalem - Palm Sunday! This came as quite a shock to me. I know that Advent is about 'Coming' - derived from the Latin word Adventum. Jesus is going to return in glory. However, I had never thought of linking this Second Coming with the Entry into Jerusalem. The other element I found stimulating was connected with the French word attendre - to wait for. As we wait for Christ to come, we must be attentive, on the lookout for the One who will bring us everything and take us to be with the Father who is the source of all that is. Just as a waiter is of service, keeping an eye out for any need a diner might have, so our attitude must be one of total attention to Christ.

So today as we begin a new Liturgical Year with the Season of Advent, let us reflect on his Triumphal Coming: the expectation of the people, their desire to make him King, their singing and waving of palms. Let us not forget how they changed on Good Friday demanding his Crucifixion! Let us look forward to Christ's Second Coming and his desire to take us to the Feast of Heaven where we will praise God eternally. How can you in your busy life be more attentive to him and the needs of the less fortunate? How can you get yourself more ready for his Return?

YEAR OF FAITH The San Damiano Crosses of St. Francis continue their journeys round our parishes underpinning the Year of Faith with prayer. A household is asked to 'host' the Cross for a week each day praying with this important Icon (with prayers provided) and one day to have a time of prayer open to others. The following weekend at Mass, the Crosses will be passed on to another person/couple/family/household. Today from St. Bonaventure's the Cross will go to Brenda French (19 Guessens Road AL8 6QL) Prayer Gathering at 3pm on Tuesday 4th. From Holy Family to Sean Cox (25 Cherry Croft AL8 7QU) Prayer Gathering on Thursday 6th at 5.30pm. Please let Fr. Norbert know if you are willing to have the Cross. Each week the households for the coming week will be published in the newsletter.
