Today we celebrate the Baptism of the Lord. What an amazing revelation - epiphany - to those who witness the event! What a profound moment for Jesus himself as his identity is affirmed!

At his Baptism, he is in solidarity with humanity as he allows John to immerse him in water and he himself sanctifies the waters which will be poured out on individuals. The Spirit which fills his whole being is the driving force in his response to the Father and he willingly breathes this Spirit upon his disciples to strengthen them and enable them to renew the face of the earth. Christ wants us all to feel the anointing of the Holy Spirit, to hear his Father affirming us as his children and to be instruments of the growth of his Kingdom.

So what about YOU? Will you let Jesus come so close to you that his life is one with yours? Are you open to the forgiveness he brings? Will you allow his Spirit to be your driving force so that your words and actions resonate with his? Are you ready to renew the face of the earth, by using the gifts his Spirit bestows? Do you really think of yourself as the Father's beloved child? There is much to reflect on as we honour the Lord's Baptism, lots to pray about and so many to intercede for as this new year unfolds and the Year of Faith progresses.
