

'Jesus let his glory be seen and his disciples believed in him.' These powerful words conclude our Gospel passage today from St. John. Jesus is present at a wedding at Cana in Galilee. His Mother notices the wine has run out and asks her Son to do something about it. Water is transformed into wine - the very best! The disciples discern what has really happened and who is the source of help and blessing at the wedding.

If you had been present what would have stood out for you? As you came to the end of the celebrations what would you have told someone else about the occasion? The Evangelist does not recount what the bride wore or the bride's mother's outfit! We do not hear about how many courses there were but only that the wine ran out. The steward realises that he is now tasting the very best and that it is there in abundance for everyone to partake and he applauds the bridegroom for his supposed decision to save the best until last. However, St. John wants us, his readers, to know that the glory of God shines out through Jesus and that his disciples have faith in him - they enter into a deep, life-giving, transforming relationship which results in their whole direction in life being focused on him.

What about you? Today in coming to Mass you must have wondered about the snow and ice and the ease with which you would get to church. You are probably thinking about the journey home. But what of your encounter with Christ in this Holy Place? What is happening which reveals his continuing glory to you? How is your faith being strengthened? St. John wants us to see - really to see! Look...reflect...open your heart to him who is the source of all life and love - Jesus Christ! Let us ask him to open us up to a fresh experience of faith which rejuvenates us and through us reveals his glory to others.
