

HOLY FAMILY

Last Sunday we heard in our Gospel passage about a wonderful day Jesus had in his home town of Nazareth. He read from the prophecy of Isaiah outlining that his ministry would be Spirit-filled and reach out to people on the margins. St. Luke left us on a note of wonder as the people marvelled at Jesus' words stating that the prophecy was coming true even as the audience listened. What more could we - or they - have wanted? The people of Nazareth think they know who Jesus really is, his origins and his 'father'; they want the Lord to work miracles for them. Suddenly it all changes. Jesus speaks the truth that God works beyond boundaries people might expect. Perhaps another way of putting it (from St. John's Gospel) might be to say that the Spirit blows where he will? The listeners' disposition turns to hostility and they try to do away with him. However, Jesus has a way of just slipping away until the moment comes for him to give his life on the Cross.

I can't help but think of Holy Week. When Jesus enters Jerusalem mounted on a donkey, the people's excitement leads them to tear palm branches from the trees and wave them shouting out 'Hosanna'; by the end of the week they have been taken over by hostility which drives them to call for him to be crucified. Between the event in Nazareth and the final journey to the Cross, there is a whole unfolding of the Gospel and a ministry of love which reaches out, forgives, heals, teaches and preaches. We have so much to learn from him about the truth of who God is and the extent to which God will go to save his people. This is at its most profound when Jesus prays for those putting him to death, forgiving them; when he breathes his last and receives from the Father life in all its fullness in the Resurrection.

Let us ask the Lord to help us to understand better the mystery of Faith. May his Spirit enlighten us! God bless you. *Fr. Norbert*
