"'What a wretched state I am in! I am lost, for I am a man of unclean lips ...and I have looked at the King, the Lord of hosts' "- The prophet Isaiah speaking after seeing the glory of God in heaven and the angels worshipping God.

"Last of all, he (Jesus) appeared to me too; it was as though I was born when no one expected it." - St. Paul writing to the people of Corinth about his commissioning to preach the Good News.

"Simon Peter fell at the knees of Jesus and said, 'Leave me, Lord; I am a sinful man.' "-The Leader of the Apostles' response to a huge catch of fish after a night of unsuccessful fishing.

What a powerful, challenging set of Scriptures are served up for us today - the final weekend before the Season of Lent begins. We are reminded of the result of encounter between God/Jesus and humanity. Isaiah, Paul and Peter experience the wonder of God revealed respectively in the majesty of heaven, on the Road to Damascus and in the enormous catch of fish by the Lake. Each recognises his unworthiness; each is commissioned with a task to be carried out in God's/Jesus' name. God/Jesus can transform sinfulness and inadequacy into something amazing in his humble servants.

On Wednesday ashes will be imposed on our foreheads marking the start of our journey towards the glory of the Cross and Resurrection of Jesus Christ. At Easter we will have the privilege of seeing God in Jesus suffer for our salvation, endure Death and rise in Victory. The ashes remind us of our fragility and sinfulness which can be turned around through Lenten repentance and works of charity. Jesus Christ wants to save us. Let us allow him to touch us with this Cross and say, 'Your sin is taken away, your iniquity is purged.' May we be transformed inwardly by God's grace and may our actions speak of God's reconciling love.

RCIA PRESENTATION This year there are 21 adults and 7 children preparing for the Sacraments at the Easter Vigil. Some will be baptised, some received into the Catholic Church; most will be confirmed and make their First Holy Communion. Today at Masses across the Garden City they are being presented and will sign a scroll which will be taken to Westminster Cathedral for the Rite of Election next Sunday (17th). Please keep them in your prayers as Lent unfolds that through their Lenten journey they may be strengthened in faith and be ready to profess this same faith at the Easter Vigil.

LENT During the Season of Lent, there will be Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at Our Lady's on Mondays 10-10.30am, at Holy Family on Thursdays 10-10.30am and at St. Bonaventure's on Saturdays 10.30-11am (except when First Confessions are celebrated, in which case 9.30-10am). There will be Stations of the Cross at Holy Family on Wednesdays 10am, St. Bonaventure's on Fridays at 10am and at Our Lady's on Fridays at 7.30pm.
