Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion 24th March 2013 (page 190)

Holy Week has arrived! Today palms are thrust into our hands and we cry 'Hosanna!' This week the Liturgies are rich in ritual and symbolism, putting us in touch with the 'Glory of the Cross' and the power of Christ's victory over suffering, sin and death. The Word of God proclaimed during the Sacred Triduum calls on us to open up ourselves to grace and love which are transforming, moulding us more firmly into the image of Jesus Christ.

Let the Lord to wash your feet! What bond do you think he is establishing with you through this sacred act? On Good Friday you will have the opportunity to approach the Cross and offer an act of reverence as you venerate it. What do you wish to leave at the Cross? Sins...suffering...the anguish of others? On Holy Saturday evening, we gather as the night sets in. The brilliance of the Easter Fire vanquishes the darkness of Christ's death and the gentle light of the Paschal Candle shines out with hope pointing the way forward. Who are the dead you will remember this Easter, hoping to meet them again in the glory of the Resurrection? What is the gloom of disappointment in your life which you want Christ to dispel? In what ways do you want the light of the Risen Lord to strengthen your faith? On Easter Sunday morning (maybe) the sun will shine, reminding us of the Son who has been raised from the dead!

Let us truly make this a Holy Week through our prayer, silence and reflection. Let us sanctify these days through coming to the various services. Let us remember with a vibrant faith all that Jesus Christ has done for our salvation and offer him our sacrifices, our love and our lives. If you are going away, may God bless your Easter wherever you are. We welcome visitors coming to share these sacred days with us. Together let us make this journey together bound firmly to Jesus Christ, our Lord and God.
