Fifth Sunday of Easter 28th April (page 271)

'Love one another' are Jesus' words in today's Gospel reading from the Last Supper in St. John. Jesus then makes more explicit what he means: we are to love one another as he has loved us. What is your experience of his love? What do you think he asking of you?

- 1. Jesus reveals to us a love which has its source in the Godhead, coming from the Father. Throughout St. John's Gospel he talks and acts in ways which show he really believes that God the Father is working through him. It is especially on the night before he dies when his disciples gather with him at table that he talks in a variety of ways about this love.
- 2. The Cross radiates love which is all-embracing. There is no one who is excluded from this love; though, of course, a person might turn his or her back on this love. The love is sacrificial, experiencing death but triumphant in the Resurrection. Forgiving love issues abundantly from the Cross just like the blood and water gushing from the wound opened up in his side when the centurion's lance pierces him.
- 3. Jesus' love can be seen when WE love! Are you ready to let the Lord's love break into our world through you? Do you truly believe in this love? Is your loving restricted to a few chosen ones or does your generosity find its way beyond expected boundaries? What does this love cost you in terms of sacrifice, forgiveness and rejection by others?

Today as we celebrate the Eucharist, we see, taste, experience and are shaped by the love of Jesus Christ. Let us allow this love to affect the way we live!
