

INTO YOUR HEART, O LORD

Many times as a boy I would be amazed and curious while watching water flow from the kitchen tap. Hot water was not so interesting because it was for washing and cleaning. Cold water was for drinking and splashing and fun! In Ireland, on the farm in Galway, there was no water piped into home (in my early childhood). As a boy I'd go with my Dad to the 'hole-in-the-ground' and bring home buckets of water. The well was a wonderful place to visit but, you soon got wise to not wasting water.

Today's first reading relates how the prophet Jeremiah was thrown down into an almost dry well. He was brought up from the 'hole-in-the-ground' and gave the people a life giving message from God. When people drink deeply of the <u>Word of God</u> they are cleansed and have life.

Christ talks of an opposite of water while speaking of fire. He wants to start a fire within each of us that will cleanse and guide us to eternal life. Division will come through those who turn away from the <u>Word of God.</u>

In Baptism we are washed clean in our preparation to serve Christ. In Confirmation the fire of the Holy Spirit enlivens the heart and soul with a love that blazes.

YEAR OF FAITH Fr. Norbert has decided to leave the procession between our churches on Sunday 22nd September. Instead he would like us to focus on the 'hosting' of the Sar Damiano Cross for the autumn. The Year of Faith will conclude with a Dinner at the Homestead Court Hotel on Saturday 16th November at 7.30pm and a Children's Mass and Party on Saturday 23rd November at 4pm. The Year officially ends on the Feast of Christ the King - 24th November. It has been a time of blessing for us in our community Let us allow the remaining months to be a continued time of enrichment.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION 2014 Application forms for St. Bonaventure's children are available at the back of church. Forms for Holy Family and Our Lady's will be available in due course. Children must be born before 1st September 2006 (i.e. they must be in at least Year 3 from September 2013) to be eligible to receive Holy Communion in 2014.

For families who attend Holy Family Church and Our Lady's Church, preparation for First Confession and First Holy Communion will start in January. There will be meeting in November for parents to register their children and receive information about dates and all that is involved. Watch this space!

CONFIRMATION We are waiting for a date for Bishop John Sherrington to celebrate Confirmation for our young people in 2014. Once this is arranged there will be a meeting in November for young people to register and information about the course to be given Preparation will begin in January.

HOLY FAMILY SCHOOL In September we welcome Ms Ginnette Stevens to Holy Family School as its new Headteacher. We are very grateful to Mr Ian Kendal and St Joseph's School in Hertford for 'sharing' Mr Kendal with us for the past two years as Executive Head and we wish him well as he 'returns' to St. Joseph's. Ms Stevens now takes up the reins at a very exciting time and will lead Holy Family towards its 50th Anniversary in 2015.

SAFEGUARDING REPRESENTATIVES Our thanks to Caroline Sherar of Holy Family who has stepped down from being the Safeguarding Representative for Holy Family. Ann Grogan has kindly agreed to undertake this responsibility and is currently getting all the necessary paperwork and training sorted out. Ann joins Peter Bell of St Bonaventure's and Barbara Moore of Our Lady's who do so much to ensure that all our procedures follow the latest national guidelines and are in keeping with the Church's high expectations.
