## Twenty-fifth Sunday of the Year 22nd September 2013 (page 140)

Just before I went away on my summer break, we read some powerful passages from St. Luke's Gospel urging us to get our priorities right. Last Sunday there were the parables of God's mercy revealing his unconditional love. Now as I return, we hear another parable from the mouth of Jesus. He tells us about a steward whose life is going to change dramatically as he is going to lose his job. He has to be ingenious in the way he responds to this major crisis. This man is shrewd and seems to take a dishonest path as he ensures he has friends who will be there for him in the future. This parable is one of the hardest to grasp fully as we don't really know what was business practice all those centuries ago and so what was the full impact of his 'dishonesty'. Leaving that to one side, the message to us is that the Kingdom is here, on our doorstep; it requires response; we have to consider our own personal future destiny.

Sometimes it can feel a lot easier for someone to tell us how to live as Jesus wants, for us to be given a step by step account of what we should do. However, each of us has such different life situations, joys and sorrows; we have responsibilities and experiences which affect us in various ways. The parables challenge us to stop and think. We have to reflect on what God is asking of me - of you. We must pray for the grace to make the right decisions and choose the paths which will bring us closer to God. Very often these can be the hardest paths of all. We need each other's support and we should put our faith in God's willingness to help us and pick us up when we fall.

Last weekend we bade farewell to Fr. Michael praying that his time in Wheathampstead will bring him and his new community many blessings. Now we await Fr. Vincent's arrival on 1st October. We have been so fortunate to have Fr. Frank Leonard's tremendous support - he certainly is being kept very busy in his retirement! I hope you have a week filled with God's presence and an awareness of the deep love he has for you.
