
## WELWYN GARDEN CITY

I write this piece late on Friday evening before setting off for Lourdes. This time last week I was with my Dad in hospital. He had rung me in the afternoon saying he had no movement in his left hand which made me think of a stroke. I was able to get home quickly and take him to A&E. While we were in the waiting room Dad asked me to anoint him. The hospital speedily gave him a clot-busting drug, took him to the stroke ward and then all we could do was wait. An MRI scan showed Dad had had a minor stroke and he went home on Tuesday. He still needs many prayers and plenty of rest. This week there have been Weddings, Funerals and Baptisms. On Tuesday afternoon a meeting of the WGC Christian Leaders with our MP Grant Shapps in the Houses of Parliament. And now Lourdes!

God works in mysterious ways. We never quite know how things will unfold. We should depend on God like the tax collector in today's Gospel parable; he trusts in the mercy of God. St. Paul writing to Timothy provides us with wonderful imagery as he soldiers on: 'I have fought the good fight to the end; I have run the race to the finish; I have kept the faith...'

This coming week the 46 pilgrims will be praying for you at the Rue du Bac in Paris at Mass on Saturday afternoon - the place where the Miraculous Medal was given; there will be many processions and Masses in Lourdes; we conclude in Nevers where St. Bernadette's incorrupt body lies. We carry your needs and intentions, those of our parishes and beyond. We are counting on YOU to pray for us for a safe journey and a blessed pilgrimage. This togetherness in prayer is crucial not only at this time but as we, a Pilgrim People, make our way towards the 'crown of righteousness reserved for us'.
