

With the school half-term break underway I am sure that for our children and staff it affords a well-earned rest...for parents and grandparents time to spend with the children!

However, as Jesus continues with the Sermon on the Mount he does not let anyone rest! He teaches that he has 'come not to abolish the Law or the Prophets... but to complete them.' The Lord proceeds to take various strands of teaching from the Old Testament and to give them an even deeper, hard-hitting edge. 'You have learnt how it was said to your ancestors...but I say this to you: - ' Christ takes us to the heart of what was taught previously and then asks his audience to heed the meaning which springs from pure motives and from the heart. You can imagine the disciples and members of the crowd gasping as he makes his pronouncements and wondering what will come next! Killing and anger, adultery and the lustful eye, divorce, the taking of oaths, saying 'Yes' and meaning it! Jesus is not afraid to speak; his words are all-embracing. We are not told of the reaction of the listeners, whether some tried to walk away or whether others attempted to intervene. He has even more to say!

Jesus' preaching cuts us to the core of our being! He invites us to give him everything. He wants the very best for us. He is patient as we respond and allows us to learn from our mistakes supported by his forgiving grace. Today as we listen to the Word of God, let us pray that we may do all we can to grasp the full impact of what Jesus is saying, to be open to the wisdom he shares with us - which is not the wisdom of the world. Let us allow the Spirit of Jesus to fill our minds and hearts, drawing us more deeply into the heart of God's compassionate love.
