Second Sunday of Lent 16th March 2014 (page 155)

The Second Sunday of our Lenten journey always has us journeying with Jesus up Mount Tabor to witness the glory of his Transfiguration. We see Jesus radiating the wonder of his Godhead with the Divinity bursting forth from every pore of his body. Moses and Elijah, representing the Law and the Prophets, are talking with the Lord. Peter wants to capture the moment by putting up tents for the three - I suppose in the way a mobile phone would be pulled out nowadays! And then the Voice is heard from a cloud: 'This is my Son, the Beloved; he enjoys my favour. Listen to him.' Suddenly they are on their own and their journey takes them back to their everyday reality.

The disciples are fortunate enough to be treated to the glimpse of the glory which will be revealed through the Death and Resurrection of Jesus. They are privileged to hear the Father's Voice reminding them of who Jesus is and what their response to him should be. At this stage of Lent, the Church wants each one us to have a taste of what is coming through our trek week by week in Lent. Our endpoint will be Calvary and the lifting up of Christ on the Cross and the radiance of his Resurrection as he bursts from the Tomb victorious. God wants us to be glorified with his Son. Our listening opens up to the teaching of One who loves the Father so much that he would be willing to give his life for our salvation. His desire to save humanity has led him as God to embrace the human race in the Incarnation, sharing our sufferings, our temptations and all that life brings us. He lifts us up to the Father so that we might enjoy eternal life and the glory of God.

This week let us imagine we are up Mount Tabor. Let us think about what we see and hear. Then let us respond! May God bless you as you walk with Jesus. *Fr. Norbert*
