

Fifth Sunday of Lent 6th April 2014 (page 170)

In today's Gospel we are taken by St. John to the village of Bethany where we meet the family of Martha, Mary and Lazarus. They matter a great deal to Jesus; he has obviously spent much time with them. A series of encounters takes place and in the spirit of St. John we are led to a wonderful experience of the true identity of Jesus! Here we encounter death, the death of Jesus' friend, Lazarus. Jesus comes face to face with mortality and the pain of bereavement as he is approached by Martha and Mary and they journey to the tomb. Jesus offers hope as he proclaims: 'I am the Resurrection and the Life'. The humanity of Jesus is so evident as he sheds tears. The tremendous faith he has in his Father shines forth as he prays and then calls his friend from the tomb. The glory of God is seen and many people come to believe in Jesus. (Think back to the first sign of Jesus in John's Gospel at the Wedding Feast at Cana when Jesus turned water into wine. The sign resulted in God's glory being seen and his disciples believing in him.)

St. John loves to challenge us! Here we, with Jesus, stare death in the face. Here we are asked to reflect on our hopes for the future and to ponder whether or not we truly believe Jesus has the power to raise us. Here in Bethany we gaze on the friendship of a family which loved Jesus to such a degree and are invited to allow the Lord to be a part of our lives. Bethany reveals to us the genuine compassion and vulnerability of Jesus who would really suffer and die, knowing pain and rejection by so many. At the grave of Lazarus we hear the riches of Jesus' prayer and are gently directed towards a mirroring of this trust in our own prayer.

In a week's time we will enter Holy Week. Bethany and the Raising of Lazarus are a stopping off point to prepare us for the final entry into the Mystery of God's Love for humanity. From this passage, see what you can learn and imitate. Allow Jesus to inspire you. Get ready to walk with him even more closely! God bless you. *Fr. Norbert*

People offered to be on a planning committee which would put together a 'spec' which would then be presented to architects for tender. Fr. Norbert wants everyone to know that nothing would start for at least a couple of years but that in principle concrete proposals can be drawn up. He is very grateful to all who came and/or offered suggestions.
