

Third Sunday of Easter 4th May 2014 (page 259)

Today we journey with two disciples to the village of Emmaus. Their walk is filled with sadness as they contemplate all that has happened in Jerusalem the previous days. Perhaps they are trying to get away from the pain and disappointment they feel at Jesus' death? Maybe the place of the Lord's Death is too much for them to bear and they have to leave? Who knows? What we do come to grasp with them is that Jesus too has been treading the same path as they have taken. He is with them - though a stranger at first - listening to them, explaining things to them and breaking bread with them. They then recognise him but he vanishes from their sight. Their memory is of their hearts burning within them. What a powerful image used to describe the presence of Christ!

There are many paths we take in life. Some are straightforward taking us where we need to be immediately. A few might take us to dead ends and we have to turn make and make a fresh start. Often we can lose our way and we meander in many directions. Have you ever thought that you are not sure where exactly you should be now? You have your gaze fixed on heaven and being with God eternally but somehow in the present moment are you all at sea and uncertain? Are you running away from events, people, places like the two disciples? The crux of this Easter passage from St. Luke is that Jesus is always with us. The Risen Lord makes himself known to us in the Scriptures, in the Community of Disciples (The Church) and in the Breaking of Bread (The Eucharist). It can be hard to see his presence; however, he is there.

Let us pray that in the coming week, whatever hardships, difficulties or disappointments we encounter, we will not give up. Let us allow the joy of meeting him here at Mass be the source of encouragement in all that we do.
