Today is Vocations Sunday. Here are some words of Pope Francis which provide us with much to reflect on and pray about:

Vocations are born in prayer Behind every vocation to the priesthood or to the consecrated life, there is always the strong and intense prayer of someone: a parent, a grandparent or a community. Vocations are born in prayer and from prayer and only through prayer can they persevere and bear fruit. *Faith makes us aware of our vocation to love* Faith is no refuge for the fainthearted but something which enhances our lives. It makes us aware of a magnificent calling, the vocation of love. It assures us that this love is trustworthy and worth embracing, for it is based on God's faithfulness which is stronger than our every weakness.

To respond to your vocation is to move towards personal fulfilment God calls you to make definitive choices, and he has a plan for each of you: to discover that plan and to respond to your vocation is to move towards personal fulfilment. God calls each of us to be holy, to live his life, but he has a particular path for each one of us.

Jesus offers us something bigger than the World Cup! Jesus asks us to follow him for life, he asks us to be his disciples, to 'play for his team'. Jesus offers us the possibility of a fruitful life, a life of happiness; he also offers us a future with him, an endless future, in eternal life...But he asks us to pay admission, and the cost of admission is that we train ourselves ' to get in shape' so that we can face every situation in life undaunted, bearing witness to our faith by talking with him in prayer.

A contagious joy Joy is born from the gratuitousness of an encounter! It is hearing someone say, but not necessarily with words: 'You are important to me'. Do not be afraid to show the joy of having answered the Lord's call, of having responded to his choice of love and bearing witness to his Gospel in service to the Church. And joy, true joy, is contagious; it is infectious...it impels one forward.

How to recognise and follow the call to priesthood or religious life Praying and walking in the Church - These two go together, they are intertwined. A powerful experience of God is always at the origin of every vocation to consecrated life, an unforgettable experience that you remember for the rest of your life! Having this familiar relationship with the Lord is like keeping the window of our lives open so that he can make us hear his voice and hear what he wants us to do.

May God bless us in our response to his calling. May God bless us with many vocations to the priesthood and consecrated life! *Fr. Norbert*
