STATEMENT FROM CARDINAL VINCENT NICHOLS

'Fr. Vincent Malone, this week, met with Cardinal Nichols and sought from him permission to step down from the role and ministry of a priest permanently and with immediate effect. Having been assured that this was a personal matter which Fr. Vincent Malone had considered carefully for many months now, the Cardinal agreed that he could do so.

This means that Fr. Vincent is no longer serving in the parishes of Welwyn Garden City.

The Cardinal asks that you keep Vincent Malone very much in your prayers and he assures you all of his prayers and concern at this moment of a difficult change.'

FROM FR.VINCENT MALONE:

'For various reasons I have this week tendered my resignation from the priesthood which has been accepted by Cardinal Vincent Nichols. I have not taken this decision lightly and it has been taken after many months of discernment. It is with the greatest sadness that I leave the priesthood. I am very sorry for any hurt or sadness that this will cause anyone and also for any time in the past when I have failed to be a true pastor to any of you. I wish to take this opportunity to thank you all for the great support you have given me during my time in Welwyn Garden City and I ask for your prayers as I begin a new stage in my life.
