## **Dedication of the Lateran Basilica 9th November** (p.192 of Mass book)

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica; it is a feast which supersedes the usual Sunday. Maybe this seems rather strange to you? What is this Basilica? Why should its Dedication be so important?

The Lateran Basilica is the Pope's Cathedral in Rome. A cathedral has a *cathedra*, the Bishop's Chair from which he governs, guides and serves his Diocese. If you have ever visited Westminster Cathedral you will know that the *cathedra* is to the left of the High Altar; its design is modelled on that of the Lateran Basilica where it lies behind the High Altar in the apse. As we belong to the Catholic Church and we are in communion with the Bishop of Rome - the Pope - so when we celebrate this feast it highlights that all the Catholic Churches throughout the world are in harmony with Rome and its Bishop. The Lateran Basilica is 'The Mother and Head of all churches throughout the world'.

A church building is a place where we encounter Christ and thus we are given a taste and a vision of heaven. Thus when the building is dedicated (or consecrated) we are honouring Jesus Christ himself. The Consecration Crosses on the walls are anointed with Sacred Chrism and the Altar has relics set into it with five Crosses cut into it representing Jesus Christ's glorified wounds (also anointed with Chrism) and a burning brazier filled with incense pointing to the Sacrificial Offering which is the Mass and the Prayer rising up to God. The Lateran Basilica was dedicated on this day in the year 324. St. Bonaventure's was consecrated on 14th September, 1974, Our Lady's on 18th December, 1973 and Holy Family on 13th May, 2007. St.Bonaventure's has twelve Consecration Crosses for the twelve Apostles, Our Lady's and Holy Family four for the four Evangelists. In each of our churches we celebrate the Sacred Liturgy, encounter Christ and are hearts are lifted up to heaven. What a great gift from God!

On this Remembrance Sunday, let us pray for the dead of the Two World Wars and subsequent conflicts, calling to mind their great sacrifice and entrusting them to God. Let us give thanks for our beautiful churches and pray that we will have a glimpse of what heaven is going to be like. Let us pray for our Holy Father, Pope Francis and give thanks for all that it means for us to belong to the Catholic Church. God bless you. *Fr. Norbert*
