Thirty-third Sunday of the Year 16th November (p.155 of Mass book)

We leave behind the Feasts of the last two weekends and now have one more 'Ordinary' Sunday before the Christ the King next weekend and then the First Sunday of Advent on 29th/30th November. Today Jesus presents us with a parable about talents and their use; this gives us a picture of what the Kingdom of Heaven is like. A talent is a HUGE sum of money and the Master bestows a number of these on his servants each according to their ability before going abroad on a journey. On his return two are commended for the wise use of the money to yield even more. The final servant is afraid and sadly hides his Master's money; he hands it back on his arrival. The Master is so disappointed at the wasted opportunity

This Kingdom proclaimed and lived out by Jesus does involve taking risks. We are offered by God so much because at the heart of the Kingdom is Jesus Christ who is the Father's Gift to us. Our faith in him - if it is to be alive - must be vibrant, should influence our way of thinking and acting; faith cannot be held to oneself but of itself should be shared with others. The latter involves the challenge of finding the right way of helping another person come to know the Lord and what it is he has to offer. At times we can do this with confidence; at other moments it can be a struggle because our way of articulating faith might not resonate with someone who does not know God yet. But it is worth it!

This week let us pray that we may recognise the great Gift God has bestowed upon us in Jesus. Let us reflect personally on how we have received faith and the possibilities God opens up for us in our daily lives. May each day be blessed by our awareness of God's presence and a willingness to bring his Kingdom closer to others as we discover the intimacy of his love for us.
