
WELWYN GARDEN CITY



Advent and Christmas are two of the Church's seasons. The word advent means *arrival*. Advent means more than preparing for Christmas. It starts each new Christian year, a period of waiting and expectancy. This happy season starts this week-end and lasts for four weeks; a time of special prayer, liturgy and scripture. Advent calls us to a new beginning. Curious about when our Lord *'will come again'* we Christians live in an 'in between period of salvation'; between the two comings of Jesus.

We await the arrival of Jesus at the end of time when he gathers us to himself, commemorated in the first two weeks of Advent. We await expectantly with hope and joy, until Jesus Christ is revealed to everyone on the last day. We then celebrate the arrival of Jesus as a baby in Bethlehem in the second two weeks of Advent. But the joy is restrained during Advent; there are no flowers at the altar and the vestments are purple so represent restraint not sadness. On the third Sunday of Advent, which we call Gaudete (Rejoice) Sunday, the vestments are a lighter shade, rose, to signify that the birthday of Jesus is getting closer; the excitement increases. This time of year can be so busy; shopping, special school events, cooking, visiting. Yes it is an exciting time, but the secular world tries to convince us that Christmas is here already. Let us not allow this beautiful season of Advent pass by in the stress of preparing for Christmas. Maybe we can be still for just 5 minutes a day and reflect on that night in Bethlehem when Jesus was really born, when God became man for each one of us and what this means to us. After all the Christmas season really only begins on Christmas day and continues well beyond St Stephen's day (Boxing Day) and the sales.
