

The Baptism of the Lord 11th January 2015 (p. 119 of Mass book)

HAPPY NEW YEAR! We gather today to celebrate the Baptism of the Lord and to bring the Christmas Season to a conclusion. At Christmas we celebrated God becoming a human being like us in all things but sin. God chose to enter time and space in Jesus Christ and through the power of the Holy Spirit continues to be with us. It is mind-blowing to ponder the fact that in One Person could be present the fullness of God and the totality of humanity. How could Jesus cope with both? Many scholars hold that the Baptism of Jesus is a defining moment in his life and ministry: he comes from Nazareth in Galilee to the Jordan and is baptised by John; he sees the heavens torn open, the Spirit coming down upon him like a dove, and hears the Father's voice announcing: 'You are my Son, the Beloved; my favour rests on you.' In a moment Jesus is aware of the life of the Trinity and is caught up in the riches of the Father's Love and the power of the Spirit who will work in him; he truly is God and yet is one of us.

I am sure that each of us experiences moments when something amazing happens to us, opening us up to what we never thought possible or the revelation of who we truly are. This stays with us always and we cherish the memory. Through his Baptism, Jesus unites himself with the whole of humanity and gives us a glimpse of how our sins are washed away through his Death and Resurrection and shows us that we too are beloved children of God on whom his favour is bestowed. We are truly human beings but because of Jesus Christ we are taken into the heart of God and his life-giving grace recreates us in the image of his Son making us divine. That also is mind-blowing!

As we journey through 2015, let us allow every day to offer us fresh ways of remembering that we are children of God. Let us seize the opportunities which come our way of letting God's grace work in us and through us in the lives of others. Let us see the face of God in our neighbour and pray that our words and actions speak eloquently of Jesus himself. God bless you and your loved ones. *Fr. Norbert*


