

HOLY FAMILY

Sixth Sunday of the Year 15th February 2015 (p. 137 of Mass book)

'If you want to, you can cure me.' These are the poignant words of the leper in today's passage from St. Mark's Gospel as he kneels in front of Jesus. The man obviously wants to be healed of his disease, but so much else will be the outcome of the healing: he will be restored to his loved ones; he will be able to touch them and concretely feel their love; he will be able to share in the life of his community and practise his religion. Jesus' response is absolutely wonderful! He says: 'Of course, I want to! Be cured!' And the miracle takes place instantly.

As you come to Mass today, what is it that you need to ask Jesus for? What weighs on your mind or troubles your heart? How are you or your loved ones affected by illness? As you look out to the wider community and to our world, what do you want the Lord to touch with his healing grace? Now that you have had a chance to reflect on that, what impact would Jesus' help have on others? If your worries melted away, what would that free you up to do? If illness or infirmity vanished, how would that affect those around you? If disease or war became things of the past, how would nations then behave in creating just situations for others? Would we remember to say: 'THANK YOU!'? Lots to think about there.

The final area I would ask you to reflect on in the coming days is related to the start of Lent. What do you need to do this Lent which would transform your life? How might your Lent 2015 be different to such a degree that you improve your relationships with others? Which parts of the world do you think might be enriched by the sacrifices you make this Lent? Imagine Jesus saying to you: 'If you want to, you can...' Hear yourself responding: 'Of course, I want to...' May God bless your Lent!

ASH WEDNESDAY This Wednesday marks the beginning of the Season of Lent with Ash Wednesday. Masses with the distribution of ashes are as follows: 9.30am at Holy Family, 12noon at St. Bonaventure's and 7pm at Our Lady's. Please remember that Ash Wednesday is a day of fasting and abstinence.

OLD PALMS If you have any old palms from previous years, why not bring them in by Tuesday morning? They will be burned to make the ashes for Wednesday.
