Palm Sunday 29th March 2015 (p.183 of Mass book)

Almighty ever-living God,

who as an example of humility for the human race to follow caused our Saviour to take flesh and submit to the Cross, graciously grant that we may heed his lesson of patient suffering and so merit a share in his Resurrection. Who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit,

one God for ever and ever. Amen.

This is the Opening Prayer of Mass today as we enter Holy Week. There is so much to meditate on in these words and a treasury of reflection for ourselves as we ponder what we will celebrate in the coming days.

- 1. Think about his example of humility to be followed.
- 2. Can you comprehend that he did it out of love for the Father and for us?
- 3. Patient suffering is that easy in your own life?

4. A share in his Resurrection - what will that be like next Sunday when we come to the glory of Easter?

God's grace is available to us especially in this Holy Week. We need to make time and space in the busy-ness of our lives with our various responsibilities and activities to enter into the Mystery of Divine Love revealed in the Cross of Jesus Christ. We will journey with Jesus from the Hosannas of Palm Sunday to Maundy Thursday with the Institution of the Eucharist and the Washing of the Feet. We will enter the Garden of Gethsemane and walk with him to Calvary. The Cross on which he is lifted up we will venerate on Good Friday. At the Easter Vigil we will - with Christians all over the world - proclaim 'He is alive!' The suffering and pain, the darkness and death will be transformed into the healing and joy, the light and hope of his New Life of Resurrection AND he wants us to have a share! Isn't that wonderful?

Wherever you spend your Easter, may God bless you and your loved ones.
