

Third Sunday of Easter 19th April 2015 (p. 258 of Mass book)

'You are witnesses to this.' These are the Risen Lord's words at the end of the Gospel today from St. Luke. He is speaking to the disciples who are 'in a state of alarm and fright ... dumbfounded.' These friends of Jesus have doubts rising in their minds and a joy so great that they still cannot believe it. What an amazing bunch! Some had recognised Jesus in the breaking of bread at Emmaus. Now the Lord stands before them showing his hands and feet; he eats some fish before their eyes. Finally, he opens their minds to understand the Scriptures and entrusts to them the responsibility of being witnesses to the whole Event of his Death and Resurrection.

How would you react if the Risen One came directly into your presence? How would you feel if he showed you the hands and feet which were nailed to the wood of the Cross? What impact would eating with him make upon you? Are you carrying out his command to be a witness to him? Of course, his Presence is different. Nevertheless he IS with us. Jesus is present in the Eucharist, in others, in situations and places. We see those glorified wounds in the hope-filled love which triumphs over suffering, in the many glimpses of light breaking into the darkness of our lives and our world. We encounter him in the Sacred Banquet of the Eucharist as he nourishes us with his very life; he is with us when we eat and drink in the every day. Your faith-filled conviction is such a great witness to Jesus. It is not wishful thinking but the power of God's Spirit at work in us.

As we begin another week in Eastertide, let us resolve to be open to the Presence of Christ - Risen and Glorious! Let us allow him to deepen the bond we have with him. Let us bear witness to him through our lives both in word and action.

WALSINGHAM PILGRIMAGE on Saturday 16th May. A coach has been booked. You need to be at Our Lady's for 7.45am and we will leave Walsingham at 5pm. We will be joining the National Pilgrimage of the Deaf. The day will include the Rosary, Walk along the Holy Mile and Mass. Hopefully the weather will be good for a picnic lunch. Walsingham in Norfolk has been a place of holiness, mystery and atmosphere for almost a thousand years since Richeldis de Faverches was inspired by Our Lady to build a Shrine in perpetual memorial of the Annunciation. One of the greatest Shrines in Medieval Christendom – when travel to the Holy Land was virtually impossible – the original Shrine was destroyed at the Reformation. Many barren years passed until the Slipper Chapel, a 14th century wayside pilgrim chapel, was restored and pilgrimage to Walsingham began once more. In 1934, the English Bishops named the Slipper Chapel, the Roman Catholic National Shrine of Our Lady. If you would like to join us on the coach, please sign your name on one of the sheets at the back of our churches. Cost: £10 for adults and £5 for children payable in advance or on the coach. If you have never been before, why not come?
