

Sixth Sunday of Easter 10th May 2015 (p. 266 of Mass book)

Did you stay up all night watching the election results or listening to the radio? As I write, it appears that the result is certain and that David Cameron will be Prime Minister again. I remember that five years ago we had to wait for some time before we knew who would lead the country and how. This time round patience is not required! The work begins and our prayers that God's Spirit will guide our leaders continue with even more fervour. Another period of history begins and we entrust ourselves and our future into God's hands.

In our First Reading today from the Acts of the Apostles, Peter is speaking when the Holy Spirit comes down upon all the listeners, Jews as well as pagans. They speak strange languages and proclaim the greatness of God. The task of Christians is not only to be in relationship with Jesus Christ and receive his Spirit, but also to proclaim him to others in every way possible and thus give glory to the Father. Last Friday evening 42 of our young people were confirmed. The Holy Spirit was poured out afresh upon them to complete what was started at their Baptism and to empower them to be adult members of the Church ready to share with others the Good News of Jesus. They too need our prayers!

In our Gospel passage from St. John, Jesus continues to speak to his disciples at the Last Supper. He is loved by his Father and he loves us. He calls us friends and has laid down his life for us. He has chosen each one of us and asks us to love others as he loves us. Powerful words which are put into action by the Lord! Powerful words and actions which we must imitate! That's the challenge.
