

Eleventh Sunday of the Year 14th June 2015 (p. 95 of Mass book)

Today green is the colour (except at the First Communion Mass)! We are well and truly back in Ordinary Time. The First Reading from the Prophet Ezekiel speaks of the shoot of a cedar which is planted on a mountain and grows into a huge tree; one of the Gospel parables highlights the mustard seed which becomes the biggest shrub of them all. Jesus was always aware of the signs around him from nature and was steeped in Scripture so he could speak in ways which opened people up from their own experience to the wonders of God's Kingdom. The Lord knew that people would respond to the clues he was giving them through the parables. He also knew that his disciples would need personal explanation to cotton on completely!

What about us? Do we really believe that the Kingdom IS happening? What is our part? Do we worry that the Kingdom might be insignificant and not have the greatness we imagine? What might help us better understand the words of Jesus? Firstly, take time to look all around you. What do you see? Is it beautiful? What did you do to make it spring into being - or who really did bring it about? As we ponder the seasons, what forces lead to change? What do we expect to happen? What might hamper the setting in of a new season? As summer now takes over our lives what hopes does that bring? What do we seeing happening in nature? in ourselves? in people's attitudes? Where does Jesus fit into all this?

Pope Francis keeps speaking of our Faith being an encounter, a personal meeting with someone - Jesus Christ. So, if we truly want to know what the Kingdom of God is like, we look to Jesus and recognise love in all its fullness, sacrifice offered up for our salvation, acceptance which make all feel welcome, hope which fortifies us in adversity. The Kingdom started off small but nothing and no-one could bring it to a stop. It is happening now and through the power of the Holy Spirit we are its agents in our day.

May God bless you in this coming week. May his Kingdom come! Fr. Norbert

BISHOP JOHN has been celebrating Masses in each parish of our Deanery and so here in WGC he will celebrate 8am Mass at St. Bonaventure's, 9.30am Mass at Holy Family and 11.30 Mass at Our Lady's on Sunday 26th July.

OVERSEAS SEMINARIANS Peter Wei from China will be ordained priest at the end of August. Cedric de la Serre from Nanterre in France will be ordained a deacon on Saturday 20th June. David Krupa will be ordained a deacon in St. Denis on Saturday 24th October. They will be in WGC the first work of September possibly with Remy Pignal from St. Denis. The Archdiocese of Seville has asked us to take two Spanish seminarians in July and so the international Church will continue to make its impact on our Garden City!

WELCOMERS It is now essential in the Diocese that all parishes have fire marshalls in case of emergency in every church at each Mass. Fr. Norbert would like some of the welcomers to take on this role so that it is clear to those present at Mass who has this responsibility. We are also expected to have a fire drill at least once or twice a year and this means evacuating the church, timing the process and keeping a log!
