

HOLY FAMILY

Fourteenth Sunday of the Year 5th July 2015 (p. 104 of Mass book)

Today we return back to our normal cycle of readings for Year B, most of which are from St. Mark's Gospel. Jesus goes to his home town together with his disciples. What a 'welcome' Jesus receives! The people know him through and through: they can name his family members and highlight his trade as a carpenter. However, even though they are aware of the miracles he worked, we are told by the Evangelist that 'they would not accept him.' What a sad moment for Jesus - rejected by the very people he knew so well. What do the disciples make of the rejection? Where is Our Lady and what is her reaction? The conclusion of the passage states that Jesus is amazed at their lack of faith and that he cannot do much there. What does he want to do over and beyond the healing of a few sick people?

This passage is a challenge to all who count themselves as people who 'know' Jesus, members of his 'family' - CHRISTIANS! Perhaps we can feel we know him so well that there is little left to discover? Maybe we are waiting for only the dramatic and miraculous to happen and are disappointed when nothing happens? In the everyday circumstances of life where is he waiting to be found? St. Mark's warning to us through this episode is that we - his followers, baptised in his name-might be the very ones who reject him because we will not allow him to come to us in his way rather than in the way we want or expect. Back in chapter 3 of this Gospel, Jesus is at home and he says: 'Anyone who does the will of God is my brother and sister and mother.' Let us pray that we may do God's will and truly be members of Jesus' family. Let us allow him to show us how we can get to know him better and deepen our love. Let us nourish our faith and pass it on to others!

PROCLAIM '15 On Saturday 11th July there will be a gathering of representatives from all over the country in Birmingham for an initiative launched by the Bishops of England and Wales called Proclaim '15. This is in response to the Pope's Exhortation Evangelii Gaudium. Stevenage Deanery is sending Susanna Hawksley from the Hitchin Parish as our representative. The Cardinal has asked every parish to have a time of Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament on 11th July. So there will be half an hour at St. Bonaventure's 10.30 - 11.00am and half an hour at Our Lady's 5.15 - 5.45pm. Our prayer is especially for a strengthening of Faith which can be shared with others so that they encounter the Joy of the Gospel.
