
WELWYN GARDEN CITY



Twenty-third Sunday of the Year 6th September 2015 (p. 129 of Mass book)

A 'new' year has begun! For those of you who have come back from holiday, I hope you are refreshed and ready for action! Some might still be planning to go away; I trust the break will come soon. I am going to start my 8th year as your Parish Priest. In the coming year there will be the Synod on the Family, the Year of Mercy will begin on 8th December and plans for our new Parish Centre will continue to develop. Of course, we are awaiting the arrival of Fr. Martin, the new Assistant Priest which will mark another chapter beginning in our community. There is so much to look forward to which will strengthen the bonds of faith and love and be evidenced in our outreach.

At the heart of the Christian Community is Christ whom we encounter in Word and Sacrament every Sunday. He is the One who nourishes us, inspires us, forgives us and helps us bring the Kingdom here on earth. Sometimes the Scriptures are complicated and need quite a bit of unravelling; at other times they are straightforward easy to grasp. We must allow this Word always to be fresh and invigorating, never taken for granted or ignored. Today in the passage from St. Mark, a deaf and dumb man is healed by Jesus as he uses the word 'Ephphatha! Be opened!' The man can then really hear sounds and use his tongue to produce words. We are given an insight into how marvellous it is to be able to hear Jesus' voice and to use our mouths to praise God and spread the message of the Gospel. This miracle leads to great rejoicing and so the Good News stirs up people's hearts with wonder.

Today, let us reflect on what we do every time we come for Mass, about the Word proclaimed and listened to, the Sacrifice offered and received, the Love connecting heaven and earth, the human and the Divine. As we hear Jesus, let us love him, treasure him and share him with others. There is no greater gift than that! God bless you in all you do and are for him. *Fr. Norbert*
