

Fourth Sunday of Advent 20th December 2015 (p. 90 of Mass book)

Have we arrived? NO!!! The fourth Advent candle is being lit at Mass today. Our Lady is visiting her cousin Elizabeth in the Gospel passage. And we still have more days ahead of us! Time seems to go slowly for some; for others there is hardly enough time for all which needs to be done.

Our Lady plays such a central role in St. Luke's account of the Birth of Jesus. She is listening and attentive at the Annunciation. She asks questions and is submissive. She says 'Yes...let it be done to me according to your word.' Today she sets off in haste to be with her elderly cousin who is also pregnant and the meeting is filled with an outpouring of the Holy Spirit. Elizabeth recognises the importance of Our Lady; John, in her womb, jumps for joy at being so close to Jesus, his Saviour, in the womb of Mary. The encounter leads to Our Lady's song - the Magnificat where all she can do is keep praising God not only for what has happened to her through divine action but also all that God is accomplishing in our world. We will hear at some of the Christmas Masses about how Our Lady treasures all the things she is told by the shepherds and ponders them in her heart.

What about us? Some are going to be making journeys to be with others for Christmas. We have in our midst visitors who have travelled to be close to loved ones for this time of celebration. There are those who are going through difficult times at this point in their lives. There are still others who are filled with joy and anticipation. God wants us ALL to receive the gift of the Holy Spirit to help us recognise the significance of Christ's Birth and let him in. God urges us to be like the angels singing of the joy of Christ's Nativity. The shepherds are chosen and have the privilege of finding the Christ Child. The same applies to us! Let us ask God's blessing upon us and our loved ones as Christmas approaches.
